### PARKS

#### Brandywine Falls

Trek to the falls and enjoy the scenery from the scenic boardwalk that is located below.

#### F.A. Seiberling Nature Realm

This serene landscape is ideal for meditation and escaping for a day.

#### Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail

This trail runs from north to south through Cuyahoga, Summit, Stark, and Tuscarawas counties.

#### Nimisila Reservoir

Enjoy all the amenities of a lake, a reservoir, fishing, and camping, with the comforts of the monitored campground, and kayak launch.

### RESTAURANTS

#### Grille 91

### MISC

#### Akron Zoo

Home to over 1,000 animals representing over 100 species, as well as a train and carousel.

#### Akron Fossils and Science Centers

Interactive exhibits, fossils, dinosaur teeth, a mastodon skeleton, and games.

#### Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad

A Class III railroad operating diesel-electric and steam-powered excursion trips through Peninsula, Ohio through the scenic Cuyahoga Valley National Park.

#### Water Works Family Aquatic Center

Water slides, lazy river, spray fountains, a zero-entry pool, and green space perfect for a picnic lunch or for kids to play.

### MUSEUMS

#### Akron Art Museum

Dedicated to enriching lives through modern art; showcases regional, national, and international art.

#### Kent Museum

Eight different galleries that feature static and rotating exhibitions of artwork. Pieces range from the 18th century through modern-day.

#### Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens

Historic house museum includes gardens, a greenhouse, carriage house, and is the birthplace of Alcoholics Anonymous.

#### Hower House at The University of Akron

This 28-room 1871 Victorian mansion was built by John Henry Hower and filled with furnishings collected in the family's world travels

#### Bethlehem Cave and Nativity Museum

Located in Nativity of the Lord Jesus Church sits this replica of the cave where Jesus was born, a 16th century church bell, and stained-glass windows depicting the Christmas gospels. Guided tours available with advanced reservation.
