PARKS

Raven Run Nature Sanctuary

MUSEUMS

Aviation Museum of Kentucky

Located at the Blue Grass Airport in Lexington, Kentucky, this museum includes over 20,000 square feet of exhibit space, a library, and an aircraft restoration and repair shop.

Farish Planetarium

The planetarium features 20+ show titles that cover topics from astronomy basics and the history of space exploration to stories of dinosaurs and the network of life on Earth.
